- 2. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with open tendering procedures contained in the Public Procurement Laws and Regulations of the Government of the Republic of Malawi and is open to all eligible bidders.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the Bidding Documents from NOCMA's Procurement and Disposal Unit, Kang'ombe House, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, West Wing, City Centre, Lilongwe, Malawi from 08:00 to 12:00hours, 13:00 to 16:00hours local time (Monday to Friday) except on Public Holidays.
- 4. A complete set of soft copy Bidding Document in English language may be purchased by interested bidders from Finance Office, Kang'ombe House, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, East Wing, City Centre, Lilongwe, Malawi upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Ten Thousand Kwacha (MK10,000.00). The method of payment will be cash.
- 5. Sealed bids in the form of **Hard Copies**, clearly marked on the outer envelope with "**Tender Description and Reference Number**" must be deposited in the **Tender Box** located at the Reception of **NOCMA**, **Kang'ombe House**, 4<sup>th</sup> **Floor**, **West Wing**, **City Centre**, **Lilongwe**, **Malawi** at or before **10:00 a.m.** (**local time**) on **Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2024.** Late bids will be rejected and returned to the bidder unopened.
- 6. It is the responsibility of each bidder to ensure that the bids submitted are in accordance with the 'Instruction to Bidders' contained in the Bidding Document; non-compliance with the instructions will lead to disqualification and rejection of the bid.
- 7. Opening of Bids shall commence at 10:00 a.m. (local time) on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2024 at NOCMA Board Room, Kang'ombe House, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, East Wing, City Centre, Lilongwe, Malawi. Interested bidders, their representatives and the public are welcome to attend.
